Nairobi Wildlife Day



Set on the southern outskirts of Nairobi, our Nairobi Wildlife Day tour is set in the world's only city national park.

You will start your day with a visit to the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust (DSWT) which is today the most successful orphan elephant rescue and rehabilitation programme in the world and one of the pioneering conservation organisations for wildlife and habitat protection in East Africa. You can spend an hour at the orphanage in close proximity to the elephants. You will hear their individual stories from keepers and learn interesting facts about elephants and conservation whilst the babies are being fed their milk.

After lunch, you will embark on a game drive set in the open grass plains with a backdrop of the city scrapers. Get ready to try and spot the endangered black rhinos, lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyenas, buffaloes and giraffes that call the Nairobi National Park home.
