River Cruise Day Trip



Take a cruise down a river in a traditional Ghanaian fishing village. Enjoy the sight of colourful fishing boats lined up along the shore and admire the beautiful flora and fauna on the various islands.

Your first island stop will be Rum Island (18+ only), where you will learn about the distillery process of rum before sampling some of the liquors created there. For groups with those under 18, the first stop will be a beautiful island, lined with palm trees, where you will all be given a fresh coconut and the opportunity to sample this tropical delight! Take some time to relax on the beach and cool your feet with a paddle in the river.

After lunch, and some time to relax at the hotel, you will head to another island where you will be greeted with a traditional Ghanaian drumming troop and dancers in traditional dress. You will have an opportunity to join in with the dancing and learn a few moves, before heading back to the docks for the drive back to Woe at sunset.

What's included?

- Return transport to docks from Woe
- Life jackets
- First island visit - Distillery visit (over 18s) or coconut tasting
- Second island visit - Drumming & dancing

What's not included?

- Lunch (Participants must buy their own lunches and drinks at the hotel)
- Drinking water
